## Types of Parks

**Neighborhood Parks** are usually within walking distance from homes and include play apparatus, benches, sport courts and picnic areas.

**Community Parks** and their facilities have all the amenities of a neighborhood park plus the benefit of sports areas.

**Pocket Parks** are small parks with playing and seating areas.

**Regional Parks** include open space areas outside the inner community of Fairfield. These areas host a variety of flora and fauna.

**Creeks Areas** include Laurel Creek and Ledgewood Creek.

**Trails** include Laurel Creek Trail and Fairfield Linear Park Trail.
